TIPS FOR THE BATTERY

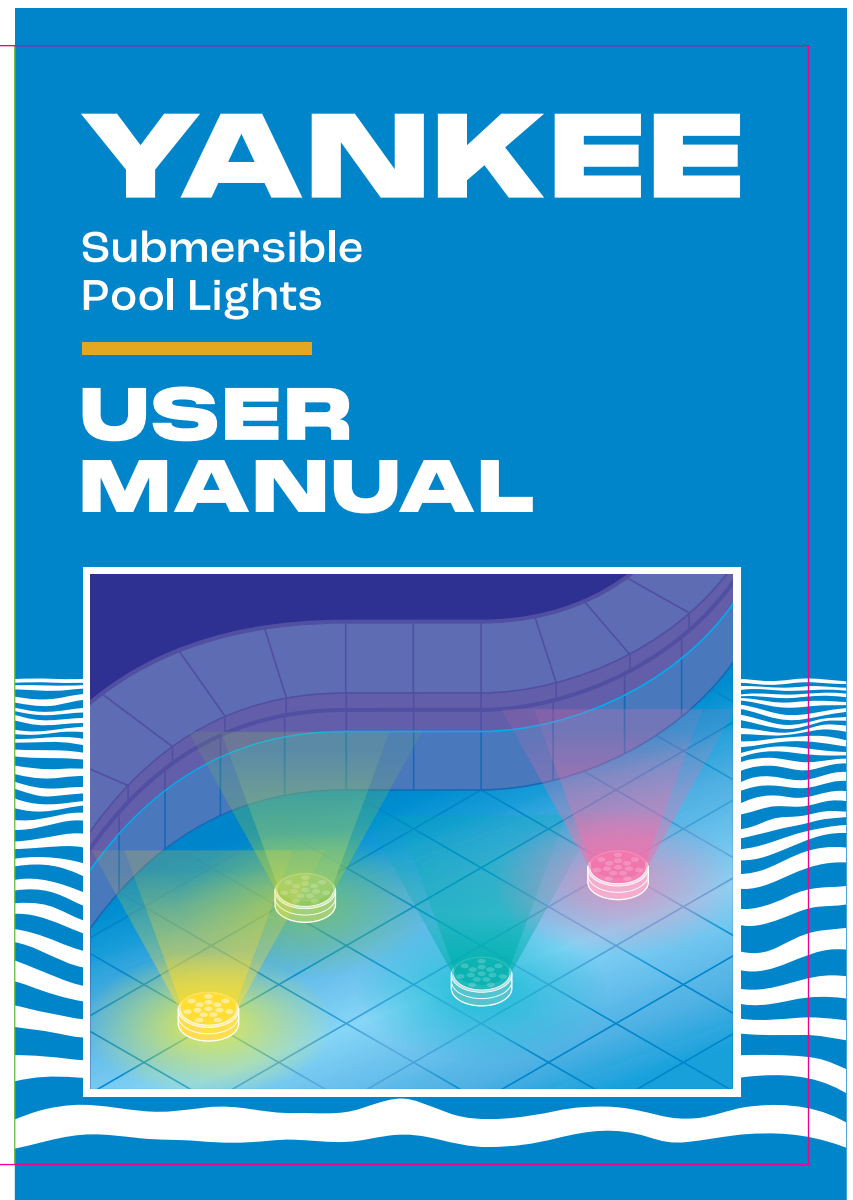
- Use 3 high-quality AA batteries. The brightness and the using time for these lights depends on the quality of the batteries.
- Press the W button on the remote control to turn on white lights and check the brightness. If the light is dim, it means that the batteries are in low power, which will reduce the sensitivity of the lights to the remote control.
- If you see a flashing red light, please replace the batteries.
- If you're not planning to use the lights for a long time, please remove the batteries to save power and protect the lights.
- Do not mix old batteries with new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), and rechargeable batteries.

TIPS FOR THE SUCTION CUPS

- Use the suction cups on smooth surfaces only. They do not work on rough surfaces.
- Clean the surface before attaching the suction cups. Make sure there is nothing between the surface and the suction cups. Foam, cleaning agents, moss, and other lubricating substances can stop the suction cups from attaching properly.
- To remove the suction cups, pull them vertically. If you pull horizontally, they may come off their grooves.

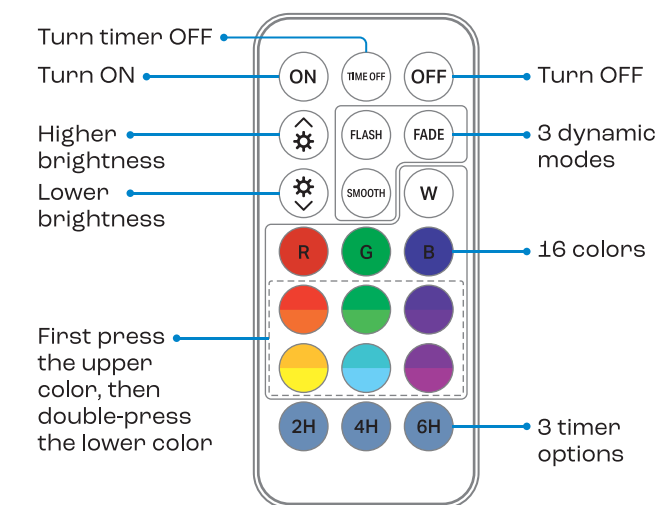

TIMER OPTIONS

- 2H: this is the default timer mode, where the lights are on for 2 hours and off for the next 22 hours. If you set the 2H timer at 8 pm, the lights will be on until 10 pm, then switch off, and then switch back on again at 8 pm the next day.
- 4H: the lights will be on for 4 hours and off for the following 20 hours.
- 6H: the lights will be on for 6 hours and off for the following 18 hours.
- The TIME OFF button turns the timer off.

INSTALLING THE LIGHTS

- 1 Unscrew the lid at the back.
- 2 Insert 3 high-quality AA batteries (not included).
- 3 Screw the lid back on tightly to ensure that the case is fully waterproof.
- 4 Attach the lights:
 - If you want to use the lights on a metal surface, you can attach them at this stage using the built-in magnet.
 - For non-magnetic surfaces, insert a suction cup into each of the four grooves on the back to stick them to the pool wall or floor.
- 5 Use the remote control to turn the lights on.
- 6 Experiment with the modes, brightness, and colors to create the lighting setup you find most enjoyable.

TIPS FOR THE USE IN WATER

- Make sure the sealing ring is in the grooves.
- Attach the cap tightly so that it can't be twisted any further before putting the lights in water.
- Do not use the lights in hot water: it can damage them.

TIPS FOR THE MAGNET

- Magnetically attach the lights to strong magnetic surfaces like iron.
- Keep the lights away from high temperatures to help maintain the strength of the magnet.
